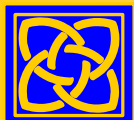

GROUNDS UPDATE

Over the term break there will be ground works happening over the 4 sites and various projects. When our students return they will notice a big difference. CAMPUS UPDATES

HEAD LICE

There has been several reported cases of head lice. This is a timely reminder to please check your child's hair and treat appropriately.

What can you do?

We seek your cooperation in checking your child's hair weekly and in those instances where head lice or eggs are found, treating your child's hair

How do I treat my child for head lice?

Purchasing and using a head lice lotion or shampoo, following the instructions on the product. Two treatments are required—seven days apart.

When can my child return to school?

Health regulations require that where a child has head lice, that child should not return to school until after appropriate treatment has started. Please note, this refers only to those children who have live head lice and does not refer to head lice eggs.

Woody Yaloak Primary School is aware that head lice can be a sensitive issue and is committed to maintaining your confidentiality. For further information please see your school office.


